

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 853

Relating to Oregon Racing Commission license fees

SB 853 increases the maximum license fees the Oregon Racing Commission may charge for various license types, including vendors, veterinarians, public training track operators, and multi-jurisdictional wagering hubs. The bill raises the individual license fee cap from \$30 to \$150 per year and increases the daily hub fee from \$200 to \$225.

Upon passage, the Commission plans to implement a tiered fee structure generating an estimated \$270,200 in additional revenue. These revenues are assumed in the Commission's budget bill HB 5035.

The Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee recommends SB 853 be reported out do pass.
