On May 27th, the General Government Subcommittee received a report from the Legislative Fiscal Office on the Review of Semi-Independent Agency Reports.

The Review of Semi-Independent Agency Reports is a summary of financial and performance data that is submitted to the Legislative Fiscal Office each biennium by 12 semi-independent agencies, as required by statute. The submitted reports cover agency performance for the 2021-23 biennium and the adopted budget for the 2023-25 biennium.

The report produced by LFO includes budget analyses for each of the 12 agencies, tables and charts summarizing budget to actual numbers, and staffing and licensing information. Eleven of the 12 agencies submitted information that complied with statutes. The Citizens' Initiative Review Commission did not submit a report as it has been nonoperational since the 2015-17 biennium due to a lack of funding. Although not required by statute, the report also includes budgetary information for the Oregon Tourism Commission.

The General Government Subcommittee recommends acknowledging receipt of the report.
