

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2208

Relating to community health improvement plans

HB 2208 modifies the requirements for community health improvement plans.

Currently, Coordinated Care Organizations are required to collaborate with local public health authorities and hospitals when conducting a community health assessment and adopting community health improvement plans. The measure broadens the list of collaborators to include community mental health programs and local planning committees related to alcohol and drug prevention and treatment services. It also requires CCOs, local public health authorities, and community mental health programs to incorporate their behavioral health plans into the community mental health improvement plan. To support these changes, the Oregon Health Authority must adopt rules to align these new requirements with existing planning and reporting obligations.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 2208 be reported out do pass.
