Subject: HB 2292 – Relating to treatment of human immunodeficiency virus.
Work Session Recommendations

The measure requires health benefit plans that currently reimburse the cost of counseling, prevention, and screening services for sexually transmitted infections to also provide coverage for USDA approved human immunodeficiency virus (HIV) prevention drugs and the services required when beginning or continuing the use of HIV prevention drugs. Impacted insurers are prohibited from requiring cost-sharing, coinsurance, or deductibles for these drugs or services, and from requiring prior authorization.

The provisions of the measure will impact the cost of health plans offered by the Public Employees' Benefit Board (PEBB) and the Oregon Educators Benefit Board (OEBB). The recommended amendment increases the expenditure limitation of the Public Employees' Benefit Board by \$767,644 Other Funds and the expenditure limitation of the Oregon Educators Benefit Board by \$682,867 to accommodate the increased plan costs.
