Work Session Recommendations

The measure directs the Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) to establish a program to assist eligible entities in paying the costs of property or liability insurance premiums for affordable housing, shelters, or other facilities. The measure establishes the Affordable Housing Premium Assistance Fund, which is continuously appropriated to DCBS for program expenditures, including DCBS administrative costs.

The -A3 amendment appropriates \$2.5 million General Fund, one-time, to DCBS in the 2025-27 biennium for deposit into the Affordable Housing Premium Assistance Fund. Additionally, the amendment provides \$2.5 million Other Funds expenditure limitation to the Department to expend the monies in the Fund.
