Subject: HB 2059 – Relating to adult behavioral health facilities.
Work Session Recommendations

The measure appropriates \$65 million General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to establish the Residential Behavioral Health Capacity Program. Through this program, OHA will distribute funding to behavioral health programs fund facilities related to withdrawal management, residential treatment, and psychiatric inpatient care. The measure declares an emergency and is effective on passage, the measure is repealed January 2, 2027.

In addition to the \$65 million General Fund, the fiscal impact of the measure, including position and contracted services costs require increased expenditure limitation of \$106,387 Other Funds and \$714,558 Federal Funds, which is reflected in the recommended amendment.
