Bill Title: Relating to the welfare of young people; declaring an emergency.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Rules to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure modifies laws related to the restraint and seclusion of children. The measure requires that certain childcare or service providers to be licensed or authorized by the Department of Human Services to provide certain types of care. It also modifies requirements for out-of-state placement for children in care. The System of Care Advisory Council is directed to study the Department of Human Services and the Oregon Health Authority's implementation of the measure and submit two reports with their findings and recommendations to the Legislature by September 15, 2026, and September 15, 2027.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
