Subject: HB 2337 – Relating to preferences for small businesses in procurement

Work Session Recommendations

HB 2337 directs the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD) to establish a program for granting preferences for state procurement of goods and services to small business enterprises. OBDD will develop a certification program for small business enterprises that can be used by state agencies to solicit bids. The measure requires OBDD to report on program participation, the number and value of state public procurement contracts awarded to small business enterprises, and assistance rendered to small business enterprises under the program.

There is a fiscal impact to the Oregon Business Development Department for program administration is \$233,373 Lottery Funds and one position (0.75 FTE) for the 2025-27 biennium. A fiscal impact statement is posted to the Oregon Legislative Information System.
