Subject:	SB 844 – Relating to public health Work Session Recommendations

SB 844 modifies updates provisions relating to Oregon Health Authority (OHA) opioid and opiate reporting, psilocybin investigations, environmental health and wastewater specialist and trainee eligibility requirements, and clinical laboratory requirements. The measure directs the OHA to provide medical assistance to individuals who are eligible for pre-release medical assistance benefits. Designees of a correctional facility may apply for medical assistance on behalf of a currently incarcerated individual to establish that individual's pre-release medical assistance benefits. The measure takes effect January 1, 2026.

There is a -A2 amendment, which makes technical changes and removes section 44, which required OHA to enroll individuals who are eligible for pre-release medical assistance benefits in the correct benefit package and allowed a designee of a correctional facility to establish pre-release medical assistance benefits for an individual who is incarcerated.
