Bill Title: Relating to artificial intelligence.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Joint Committee on Information Management and Technology to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Senator Aaron Woods Commission on Artificial Intelligence (AI) within the Department of Justice to serve as a central resource to monitor the use of AI technologies and systems and report on long-term policy implications. Additionally, the measure requires the Attorney General to employ a Chief Artificial Intelligence Officer. The measure provides an unspecified General Fund appropriation to the Department of Justice to hire additional employees to support the Officer's duties as required by the measure.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
