HB 2292

Relating to treatment of human immunodeficiency virus

HB 2292 requires health benefit plans that currently reimburse the cost of counseling, prevention, and screening services for sexually transmitted infections to also provide coverage for approved human immunodeficiency virus prevention drugs and the services required when beginning or continuing the use of such prevention drugs.

The bill includes Other Funds expenditure limitation increases of \$767,644 for the Public Employees Benefit Board and \$682,867 for the Oregon Educators Benefit Board to accommodate the estimated increase in expenditures for costs of health care plans offered by the boards.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends HB 2292 be amended by the –A4 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
