Work Session Recommendations

The measure makes several modifications to the Alcohol and Drug Policy Commission (ADPC) including expanded fiscal and contractual powers, changes in membership composition and representation, and renaming and modifying required content and purpose of statutory plans.

Although the fiscal impact statement prepared for the measure outlined the costs associated with three additional positions to implement the changes required in the measure, those positions are duplicative to positions that were authorized to be established in the primary budget bill for the Oregon Health Authority, HB 5025.
