Subject: HB 3037 – Relating to state grants awarded by the Department of Education
Work Session Recommendations

House Bill 3037 awards minimum grant awards to school districts with less and 1,650 students unless a minimum grant award is established in statute. Additionally, the measure adjusts the eligibility for the High School Graduation and College Readiness Act Grants, Early Warning System Grants, and the Student Investment Account Grants to include the Oregon School for the Deaf, eligible day treatment programs, Youth Correction Education Programs, and Juvenile Detention Education Programs. The measure has no fiscal impact; however, the measure will change the distribution of currently funded grant awards.
