Subject:	SB 976 – Relating to providing animal health care Work Session Recommendations

The measure directs the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) to establish by rule circumstances when individuals without a license to practice veterinary medicine who have received training in cattle pregnancy verification may perform verification services. Additionally, the measure requires individuals who are performing cattle pregnancy verification to report livestock diseases.

A task force on Equine Dentistry is created in the measure but is removed in the proposed —A5 amendment.

The measure declares an emergency and is effective upon passage with cattle pregnancy verification operative January 1, 2026, allowing time for rule making. Costs anticipated to implement the measure are minimal and absorbable with ODA's budget, SB 5502 (2025).

Amendment
