Summary of Revenue Changes

House Bill 3589 transfers \$24.0 million from the Senior Property Tax Deferral Revolving Account to the General Fund and then appropriates \$24.0 million General Fund to the Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD). Of this amount, \$23.5 million will be deposited into the General Housing Account (GHA) to fund development, rehabilitation, or preservation of housing for older adults and persons with disabilities. Annual transfers to HCSD from the Senior Property Tax Deferral Revolving Account in excess of the amount required to fund tax deferral obligations will occur between January 2027 and July 1, 2031, when the transfer provisions of the measure are repealed.

Summary of Transportation and Economic Development Subcommittee Action

House Bill 3598 directs HCSD to establish and maintain a senior housing development initiative to incentivize housing targeted to older adults and persons with disabilities. The bill requires HCSD to provide technical assistance to developers, affordable housing and service providers, planners, stakeholders, and local governments to ensure housing developments meet the needs of older adults. HCSD must also provide regular public updates that track goals and progress relating to affordable rental housing targeted towards populations of older adults and persons with disabilities.

The Subcommittee recommended a \$24.0 million General Fund appropriation, of which \$0.5 million is to be used to provide the technical assistance required in the bill. The remaining funds, \$23.5 million, are to be deposited into the GHA and will be expended as Other Funds for the development, rehabilitation, or preservation of housing for older adults and persons with disabilities.
