# **Summary of Revenue Changes**

Senate Bill 1168 appropriates \$159,362 General Fund to the Bureau of Labor and Industries (BOLI) to provide the resources necessary to implement and administer the bill.

## **Summary of Human Services Subcommittee Action**

Senate Bill 1168 prohibits home health agencies and hospice programs from paying staff on a per-visit basis. The bill expands the provisions prohibiting per-visit compensation from nurses to "home health care staff" or "hospice care staff," which includes home care workers, direct care workers, physicians, nurse practitioners, psychiatrists, psychologists, volunteers, or certain supervisors.

The Subcommittee recommended \$159,362 General Fund to BOLI for one permanent, full-time Compliance Specialist 1 position (0.75 FTE) and services and supplies necessary for enforcing compliance for the provisions of the bill.
