HB 2059

Relating to adult behavioral health facilities

HB 2059 makes a one-time \$65 million General Fund appropriation to the Oregon Health Authority to establish the Residential Behavioral Health Capacity Program. Funding is to be distributed to behavioral health programs to fund facilities related to withdrawal management, residential treatment, and psychiatric inpatient care. Seven limited-duration positions are authorized for the administration of the program. Administrative expenses, including position and contracted services costs, total \$1.2 million General Fund, \$106,387 Other Funds, and \$714,558 Federal Funds, which is reflected in the recommended amendment.

The measure declares an emergency and is effective on passage, the measure is repealed January 2, 2027.

The Subcommittee recommends HB 2059 be amended by the –A4 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
