

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 476

Relating to professional workforce

SB 476 expands training requirements for professional licensing boards and permits the Oregon Medical Board to establish a provisional license for internationally trained physicians.

The measure requires staff of professional licensing boards that regularly interact with internationally educated individuals through their licensure process to attend culturally responsive training approved by the Office of Immigrant and Refugee Advancement. Additionally, the Oregon Medical Board may offer a provisional license to individuals who are qualified, licensed, and internationally trained.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 476 be amended by the –A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
