Relating to gun dealer licenses

HB 3076 requires the Oregon Department of Justice to issue state firearms dealer licenses beginning July 1, 2027. The measure creates procedural and eligibility requirements for the application, issuance, and oversight authority of state firearms dealer licenses. The measure also establishes minimum requirements for the employees of a licensed firearms dealer as well as minimum security and storage requirements for a place of business where firearms are sold. The Department is also required to conduct inspections of licensees. The measure directs the Department of Justice and the Oregon State Police to adopt rules as necessary to implement the measure.

The amendment changes operative dates and frequency of inspections, removes the emergency clause, and adds funding to implement the measure.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends HB 3076 be amended by the –A5 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
