SB 960 is a non-appropriation measure that makes necessary changes in statutes and session law to support the 2025-27 legislatively adopted budget, to clarify the application of statutes for the budget, and modify provisions relating to the use of funds. Specifically, the measure:

- Transfers \$15 million from the Oregon CHIPS Fund, \$3 million from the OWEB Flexible Incentives Account, and the \$9 million balance in the Agricultural Overtime Fund to the General Fund,
- Repeals the Summer Learning Fund and transfers any balance to the General Fund,
- Transfers \$14.7 million from the Workers' Benefit Fund to the Wage Security Fund,
- Suspends the 1 % transfer to the Rainy Day Fund for the 2023-25 biennium, and
- Expands the eligible uses of the Protection and Education Account.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 960 be amended by the –3 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
