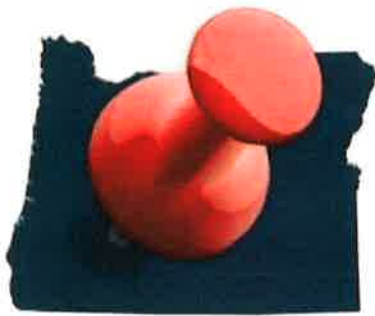

Oregon's smallest municipalities need a level playing field when it comes to affording the grant funds needed for critical infrastructure repairs and upgrades. **HB3654** will make it easier and less expensive for small cities to apply for grants and execute projects by **capping the matching funds requirements of those grants at lower levels for small cities**, on a sliding scale, based on population.

Additionally, **HB3654** will expand the allowable uses of these grants to help small cities manage and afford important projects end to end.
