

Vote YES on Senate Bill 551

Plastic pollution harms the environment, endangers public health, and is an increasing concern for Americans. To reduce plastic waste, we must limit the disposable products handed to consumers daily and stop producing unnecessary plastic items that are easily replaceable with sustainable alternatives.

Senate Bill 551 would reduce plastic by eliminating all plastic film bags at checkout at grocery stores and restaurants starting on January 1, 2027.

A February 2025 poll by Oceana shows a majority of Republican, Democrat, and Independent voters are concerned about plastic pollution, including 68% support for phasing out plastic bags.
