SUMMARY

Digest: Directs ODE to study how to fund the costs for a single point of entry at schools. (Flesch Readability Score: 85.0).

Directs the Department of Education to conduct a study to identify sources of funding to pay for the costs of establishing a secure, single point of entry for each public school.

Directs the department to submit a report to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2026.

Sunsets January 2, 2027.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.
