SUMMARY

Digest: The Act says that a defendant wearing a mask during a crime for specified reasons can increase the sentence. (Flesch Readability Score: 62.8).

Requires the court to consider the defendant having a concealed face during the crime, with the intent to avoid arrest or facilitate the commission of the crime, as aggravation for sentencing purposes.
