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SUMMARY

Digest: The Act says that substitute teachers can enroll in a health benefit plan with OEGB. The Act says that the teacher has to pay 10 percent of the premiums. The Act says that the teacher's home district has to administer the plan for the teacher and pay the rest of the premiums, but the district will be paid back by OEGB. The Act says that a district has to keep old health care benefits for teachers who cannot enroll in an OEGB plan. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.6).

Provides that certain substitute teachers are eligible to enroll in a health benefit plan offered by the Oregon Educators Benefit Board. Requires the substitute teacher to pay 10 percent of the premiums for the plan. Requires the substitute teacher's chosen home district to administer the plan for the substitute teacher and pay the remaining premiums, subject to reimbursement by the board.

Requires a district to maintain legacy health care benefits for substitute teachers who are not eligible to enroll in a health benefit plan offered by the board.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.
