## SUMMARY

Digest: The Act would limit the power of the government or private person to make people get some medical care that they do not want. The Act would ban the government or private persons from treating people who choose not to get some medical care differently. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.7).

Prohibits public bodies and private entities from requiring a person to receive an experimental medical intervention or vaccination or to possess an immunity passport, immunity pass or other evidence certifying a vaccination or immunity status.

Prohibits public bodies and private entities from discriminating against a person because the person chooses not to receive an experimental medical intervention or vaccination or fails to possess an immunity passport, immunity pass or other evidence certifying vaccination or immunity status.

Prohibits public bodies and private entities from interfering with certain rights on account of risks presented by a pandemic.

Declares an emergency, effective on passage.
