

## **Open Government Impact Statement**

83rd Oregon Legislative Assembly 2025 Regular Session

Measure: HB 2812

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## SUMMARY

Digest: Exempts some client health info that the PSRB has from disclosure to the public but allows for its release in some situations. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.4).

Exempts individually identifiable health information in possession of the Psychiatric Security Review Board from disclosure under public records laws and allows for disclosure in certain circumstances.

## **OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT**

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure the information about individually identifiable health information in possession of the Psychiatric Security Review Board. This measure allows for disclosure in certain circumstances as authorized by the board, including but not limited to: carrying out the board's statutory obligations, reporting to the National Instant Criminal Background Check System, and in emergency circumstances.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain information relating to specific health information of clients whom the Psychiatric Security Review Board has jurisdiction over.
