**Bill Title:** Relating to State Parks and Recreation Department procurements; prescribing an effective date.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Administrative Services, Parks and Recreation Department

## Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Natural Resources and Wildfire to the Senate Committee on Judiciary.

The measure exempts the State Parks and Recreation Department from procurement and printing rules for certain activities, including contracting with small businesses and producing promotional materials. It allows the department to conduct procurement and printing for park-related communications and education purposes. The measure takes effect on the 91st day after sine die.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Senate Committee on Judiciary.

## Further Analysis Required
