SUMMARY

Digest: Makes the home address and phone number of some OLCC permittees exempt from public disclosure. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.8).

Exempts from public records disclosure the residential address and personal phone number of an individual who holds a specified permit issued by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure the residential address and personal phone number of an individual who holds a permit issued by the Oregon Liquor and Cannabis Commission that allows the individual to perform work for or on behalf of a marijuana retailer or laboratory.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could obtain the residential address and personal phone number of an individual who holds a permit issued by the commission that allows the individual to perform work for or on behalf of a marijuana retailer or laboratory.
