Measure Description

The Oregon State University Extension Service is directed to establish a program to assist households that rely on wells for drinking water or septic systems for wastewater treatment, with a focus on areas of ground water concern under ORS 468B.175. The program will provide outreach, research, education, resource navigation, and monitoring. The measure appropriates \$2,500,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) for distribution to the Oregon State University Extension Service. Additionally, \$5,000,000 General Fund is appropriated to the Water Resources Department (WRD) for deposit into the Water Well Abandonment, Repair and Replacement Fund, and \$5,000,000 General Fund to the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) for septic system low-interest loan programs.

Fiscal Analysis

The fiscal impact is estimated to be \$12.5 million General Fund in the 2025-27 biennium, which the measure appropriates across DEQ, HECC, and WRD.

Department of Environmental Quality

The measure provides a one-time \$5 million General Fund appropriation in the 2025-27 biennium for administration of the Onsite Septic Loan Program under ORS 454.777 and 454.779. DEQ will disburse these

funds within the existing program structure, with the grant administration workload being absorbed by current staff.

Higher Education Coordinating Commission

The measure makes a one-time \$2.5 million General Fund appropriation to HECC for distribution to the Oregon State University Extension Service in the 2025-27 biennium. Approximately \$2 million is expected to cover salary and service and supply costs for seven full-time and one part-time position, including a statewide manager responsible for program oversight, curriculum development, technical assistance, and managing education and outreach efforts. The appropriation also includes approximately \$80,000 for technology and communication tools, \$100,000 for travel, and \$300,000 for program implementation and monitoring.

Water Resources Department

The measure makes a one-time appropriation of \$5 million General Fund to WRD for deposit into the Water Well Abandonment, Repair, and Replacement Fund. WRD will manage the funds within existing staff resources.

WRD's budget will require an increase in Other Funds expenditure limitation to expend the funding deposited in the Water Well Abandonment, Repair and Replacement Fund.

Relevant Dates

The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.
