**Measure Description:**

Increases the percentage, from 20 percent to 50 percent, that the Construction Contractors Board may retain of the proceeds of civil penalties they impose.

**Revenue Impact:**

A revenue loss of roughly \$0.345 million per biennium.

**Impact Explanation:**

According to the Construction Contractors Board (CCB), they collect roughly \$1.15 million in these penalties per biennium, retaining an average of \$0.23 million as operating revenue. The difference (\$0.92 million) is transferred to the General Fund. The CCB estimates that the higher percentage would result in roughly \$0.575 million per biennium being retained for operations, resulting in the projected biennial revenue loss of \$0.345 million.
