SUMMARY

Digest: States that parents have the right to make certain decisions about their children. Requires the approval of the voters. (Flesch Readability Score: 68.0).

Proposes an amendment to the Oregon Constitution to provide parents with the fundamental right to direct the upbringing, education and care of their children.

Refers the proposed amendment to the people for their approval or rejection at the next regular general election.
