**Measure Description**

This measure provides one-time General Fund appropriations totaling \$420,000 in the 2025-27 biennium to the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for distribution to Marion Lawyers Charitable Corporation and Polk County to expand free drop-in childcare programs for people with county or governmental business.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The total fiscal impact of this measure is \$420,000 General Fund for the 2025-27 biennium. The administrative costs for DAS to distribute these funds to the counties can be absorbed within current resources. Marion County Lawyers Charitable Corporation and Polk County would each receive \$210,000.

**Relevant Dates**

The measure declares an emergency and takes effect on passage.
