WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Appropriates \$400,000 from the General Fund to the Department of Justice (DOJ) for the Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force to manage the Oregon SAE/SANE Certification Commission.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

Provisions of the measure.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Attorney General's Sexual Assault Task Force (SATF) develops best practice protocols for coordinated responses to sexual assault survivors, including oversight of the Oregon SAE/SANE Certification Commission, which certifies that a medical provider possesses the necessary knowledge, skills, and expertise to effectively respond to and care for sexual assault survivors. House Bill 3070 appropriates state funds to the DOJ for SATF to manage the SAE/SANE Certification Commission for purposes of outreach, training, technical assistance, establishing competencies and standards, membership oversight, and multidisciplinary work with entities including law enforcement agencies, hospitals, and community-based victim services organizations.
