## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the After-School Learning and Enrichment Grant Program for the purpose of funding after-school learning and enrichment programs for youth in kindergarten through grade 12, especially youth from rural areas or historically underserved populations. The Oregon Department of Education (ODE) will administer the program and award grants to school districts, education service districts, public charter schools, the nine federally recognized Indian tribes in Oregon, and organizations that provide learning and enrichment opportunities. The measure provides an unspecified General Fund appropriation to ODE to administer the program.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
