## WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure repeals the Oregon Medical Board's Volunteer Emeritus License, which allows out-of-state physicians to practice medicine on a volunteer basis in Oregon.

## **ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

#### **EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

## **BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Medical Board's Volunteer Emeritus License is available for physicians with a current license issued in another state to volunteer at health clinics in Oregon (ORS 677.120 and OAR 847-023). As of February 3, 2025, there are no active Volunteer Emeritus Licenses issued in Oregon (License Totals Report). House Bill 4096 (2022) permits physicians with a current license issued in another state to practice medicine in Oregon on a volunteer basis for up to 30 days (ORS 676.347).

Senate Bill 873 repeals ORS 677.120 and the Oregon Medical Board's Volunteer Emeritus License while continuing to permit physicians with a current license in another state to practice in Oregon under ORS 676.347.
