WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure designates the third Tuesday of March of each year as Oregon Farmer and Rancher Day. It declares an emergency and takes effect on its passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Selection of the date
- Provisions of the measure

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

The amendment changes the date of Oregon's Farmer and Rancher Day from October 12 to the third Tuesday of March and changes the measure's effective date.

BACKGROUND:

Based on the 2022 U.S. Census of Agriculture, there are 68,564 producers in Oregon operating 35,547 farms, the majority of which are small-acreage. Oregon currently lists 39 commemorative days, weeks, and months in statute.
