SUMMARY

Digest: The Act makes changes to laws involving the welfare of young people. (Flesch Readability Score: 74.8).

Modifies provisions regarding the use of restraints and involuntary seclusion on certain young people.

Modifies provisions regarding investigations of abuse of certain young people.

Modifies provisions regarding licensing of child-caring agencies.

Modifies provisions regarding out-of-state placements of children in care.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure all information requested or received by the Department of Human Services related to secure nonmedical transportation of children by a provider as described in ORS 418.241.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could gain information relating to transportation services provided to children by a licensed secured nonmedical transportation service.
