Bill Title: Relating to arts and culture.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Economic Development, Small Business, and Trade to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure abolishes the Oregon Arts Commission and the Oregon Trust Cultural Development Board and combines them into the Oregon Arts and Cultural Development Board to govern the newly established Oregon Arts and Cultural Development Office, a semi-independent state agency. The commission and the board are currently housed within the budget of the Oregon Business Development Department (OBDD). The measure would have budgetary implications once it becomes operative in July 2027, as OBDD resources would be transferred to the new semi-independent state agency.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
