SUMMARY

Digest: The Act tells OHA to create a respite care program for unpaid caregivers of children and youth with complex mental health needs. (Flesch Readability Score: 61.4).

Requires respite care services to be provided through the state medical assistance program to provide relief to unpaid caregivers of individuals under the age of 26 who have complex mental health or substance use-related needs.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
