Bill Title: Relating to economic development districts; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Oregon Business Development Department, Department of Administrative Services, Counties, Confederated Tribes of Coos, Lower Umpqua and Siuslaw Indians, Burns Paiute Tribe, Confederated Tribes of Grand Ronde, Confederated Tribes of Siletz, Confederated Tribes of Umatilla Indian Reservation, Confederated Tribes of Warm Springs, Coquille Indian Tribe, Cow Creek Band of Umpqua Indians, Department of Administrative Services, Klamath Tribes

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Economic Development, Small Business, and Trade to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure allocates \$1.7 million from the Administrative Services Economic Development Fund in the 2025-27 biennium for the purpose of distributing \$70,000 each year of the biennium to each of 12 economic development districts, as defined by statute. However, the measure does not specify which agency is allocated the \$1.7 million. Each economic development district shall use the moneys to receive federal matching grants awarded by the U.S. Department of Commerce.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
