Bill Title: Relating to state grants awarded by the Department of Education; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Education, School Districts, Oregon Youth Authority, Counties

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure allows the State Board of Education to award a minimum grant amount to school districts with less than 1,650 students, unless a minimum grant amount is provided by statute. The measure also expands eligibility and makes funding adjustments for the High School Graduation and College Readiness Act, the Student Investment Account Grants, and the Early Warning System Grants to allow additional schools or education organizations to access to these grants. The measure changes the required reporting date related to grants that are provided to the English Language Learners Program Grant.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
