## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on High Education and Workforce Development to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure makes a one-time appropriation of \$40,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) in the 2025-27 biennium for purposes of a pilot program at the University of Oregon to train graduate-level student clinicians who are studying to become speech-language pathologists to use a family-centered approach when serving children with augmentative and alternative communication needs in a traditional overnight summer camp setting.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
