Bill Title: Relating to consumer engagement in the behavioral health care system; declaring an emergency.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Human Services, Oregon Health Authority

## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Early Childhood and Behavioral Health to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes the Oregon Wellness and Community Stability Act. The measure appropriates an unspecified amount of General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority to establish a program that increases consumer involvement with access and delivery of behavioral health services. The measure appropriates an additional unspecified amount of General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority to establish a pilot program to create a long-term residential treatment program for young adults between the ages of 18-25 experiencing psychosis who also have a substance use disorder.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
