Bill Title: Relating to adults in custody.

Government Unit(s) Affected: Department of Corrections, Department of Public Safety Standards and Training, Judicial Department, Oregon Health Authority, Counties, Office of the Governor, Criminal Justice Commission, Department of Human Services

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Judiciary to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure creates a position within the office of Corrections Ombudsman to ensure compliance from the Department of Corrections (DOC) with operations surrounding best practices of the Prison Rape Elimination Act of 2003. The measure also focuses on operations of DOC and requires actions and studies on behalf of the Department in conjunction with other agencies.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
