Bill Title: Relating to municipal solid waste; prescribing an effective date.

Summary of Fiscal Impact

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Climate, Energy, and Environment to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure establishes a 12-member Task Force on Municipal Solid Waste in the Willamette Valley. The task force is required to study and identify solutions for solid waste disposal in the Willamette Valley and review the findings and recommendations of the Regional Sustainable Materials Management Plan Task Force. The Legislative Policy and Research Office is required to provide staff support to the task force. The task force is repealed on December 31, 2026.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
