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SUMMARY

Digest: The Act says what the "five-needle protocol" is and who can perform it. (Flesch Readability Score: 71.7).

Defines "five-needle protocol." Allows the Oregon Medical Board to establish a registry of individuals who are qualified to provide the five-needle protocol. Provides that only an individual included on the registry may provide the five-needle protocol. Creates an exception. Exempts an individual included on the registry from the requirement to obtain a license to practice acupuncture.

Takes effect on the 91st day following adjournment sine die.
