The revenue impact of this measure is indeterminate for the following reasons:

Although the bill directs one half of all future restitution payments to insurance carriers from criminal cases be directed to Department of Justice (DOJ), the bill provides the option for insurance carriers to seek damage recovery through civil instead of criminal cases. In those instances, restitution would not be collected through the court and no payments would be sent to DOJ.

Restitution that will be ordered to insurance carriers in criminal cases (1/2 of it to DOJ) might represent additional state revenue, however, the extent to which those insurance carriers may instead seek reimbursement through civil cases might make limit the revenue yield to the state.
