## **Summary of Fiscal Impact**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Climate, Energy, and Environment to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure requires the Oregon Department of Energy (ODOE) to create a statewide clearinghouse for energy and an energy efficient incentive program. ODOE is required to work with the Department of Revenue to establish an automatic income verification for energy and an energy efficiency incentive program. Additionally, this measure expands the single resource requirements in ORS 469.161 by requiring the Department to coordinate with industry and labor organizations, ensure information is available English and Spanish, conduct outreach, provide a list of preferred contractors, provide training and education on incentives, and establish a support system for the single resource hub that uses natural persons.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
