WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

The measure appropriates \$2,200,000 from the General Fund to the Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) for the 2025-2027 biennium for distribution to Southern Coos Hospital and Health Center to expand access to primary, specialty, and pharmacy services. Declares emergency, effective July 1, 2025.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Health care access.
- Impact of the measure.

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Southern Coos Hospital and Health Center (SCHHC) is a 24-bed facility in Bandon, Oregon, serving residents of Southern Coos County and Northern Curry County. SCHHC is a critical access hospital and offers a broad continuum of care including primary care and long-term care. In SCHHC's service area, 35 percent of the population is aged 60 or older and 16.3 percent of residents live in poverty. (SCHHC Community Health Needs Assessment, 2023).

Senate Bill 1050 appropriates \$2,200,000 from the General Fund to Southern Coos Hospital and Health Center to expand access to primary, specialty, and pharmacy services.
